





USS INTREPID SEA, AIR AND SPACE

The Intrepid Sea, Air & Space Museum

Located on the West Side of Manhattan, the Intrepid showcases the World War II Aircraft carrier USS Intrepid, the submarine USS Growler and a Concorde supersonic airplane. The Intrepid is also host to OSO Manhattan, a USMC recruiting station. In September 2001, The Intrepid served as temporary field headquarters for the FBI as it began its investigation of the 9/11 World Trade Center attacks. Experience this dynamic adventure!

Space Shuttle Pavilion

Within the Pavilion, Enterprise sits just 10-feet off the ground, allowing visitors to walk directly underneath this historic artifact. 
