

Visit the John F. Kennedy Presidential Library & Museum

Visit the JFK Library & Museum in the striking I. M. Pei building on Boston's Waterfront located on Columbia Point. The Library and Museum is set on a ten acre park landscaped with pine trees, shrubs and wild roses reminiscent of the landscape of Cape Cod familiar to President Kennedy.

Experience the Museum through three theatres, period settings and 25-dramatic multimedia exhibits. Enter The recreated world of the Kennedy Presidency for a "first-hand" experience of John F. Kennedy's Life, legacy and leadership.

Tour the USS Constitution (self-guided)

Visit one of Boston's most treasured landmarks, the USS Constitution. Get on board "Old Ironsides" at her home in the Charlestown Navy Yard. "Old Ironsides" is the oldest commissioned warship in the world. USS Constitution is one of six ships Ordered by President George Washington to protect America's growing maritime interests in the 1790s. 


